Earthworms eat leaves, and roots, and even animal poop! It churns around inside their tummies and then they POOP OUT fertilizer that feeds our plants and trees!



Too much sunlight or freezing temperatures will kill them!

After it rains and you see worms on a sidewalk, they are trying to get to a new piece of ground.

If they're in the sun too long, they will die.

If you'd like to help them, gently pick them up and place them on dirt.
